

MARIPOSA COUNTY RESOLUTION NUMBER 95-46
RESOLUTION SUPPORTING SENATE BILL NUMBER 150
AMENDING SECTION 11005 OF THE REVENUE AND TAXATION CODE AND
SECTIONS 2105 AND 2107 OF THE STREETS AND HIGHWAYS CODE

WHEREAS, every resident of California has a right to benefit from the services provided with the taxes they pay; and

WHEREAS, every resident of California pays an equivalent share of certain vehicle license fees, gas taxes and diesel taxes; and

WHEREAS, said taxes are allocated equally between counties and cities, one-half to each; and

WHEREAS, services provided with said tax receipts within a city benefit county residents; and

WHEREAS, services provided with said tax receipts by a county benefit city residents; and

WHEREAS, only those residents of Alpine, Mariposa and Trinity Counties, the only counties that do not include a city, receive no benefit from the city share of their taxes; and

WHEREAS, enactment of Senate Bill Number 150 will redefine a "city and county" for the apportionments of vehicle license fees, gas taxes and diesel tax revenues, to include a county that does not contain any incorporated city in its boundaries; and

WHEREAS, enactment of Senate Bill Number 150 is necessary to equitably allocate the taxes paid by the residents of Alpine, Mariposa and Trinity Counties.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of Mariposa County, a political subdivision of the State of California, hereby requests that Senate Bill Number 150, amending section 11005 of the Revenue and Taxation Code and sections 2105 and 2107 of the Streets and Highways Code, be enacted by both Houses of our State Legislature and signed into law by our Governor.



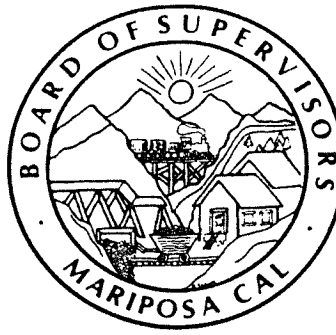
