RECOMMENDED ACTION AND JUSTIFICATION: (Policy Item: Yes\_\_\_ No X)

Public Works recommends adoption of the attached Resolution incorporating Program Supplement No. 014 into the Local Agency- State Agreement for Federal Aid and authorization for the Public Works Director to sign the Agreement. This provides estimated funding of \$45,600 ( 80%) for the design of this bridge rehabilitation Project on Darrah Road at West Fork Chowchilla River. The remaining costs will be paid by the Road Fund.

This work is an HBRR (Highway Bridge Replacement and Rehabilitation) Project funded under Federal Aid # STPLHG-5940(001). This is one of the four projects approved by Caltrans in September, 1994. We are currently negotiating with Merced County for assistance in design and environmental investigations.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

The most recent project completed under this program was replacement of a bridge on Indian Peak Road at the Middle Fork Chowchilla River.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING INCORPORATION OF PROGRAM  
SUPPLEMENT 014 INTO THE LOCAL AGENCY - STATE  
AGREEMENT FOR FEDERAL AID, PROVIDING FUNDING  
FOR THE BRIDGE REHABILITATION PROJECT,  
DARRAH ROAD AT WF CHOWCHILLA RIVER, #40C-0033

WHEREAS, an agreement was entered into between Mariposa County and  
the State of California on 08/21/79 regarding Federal Aid; and

WHEREAS, Program Supplement No. 014 to Local Agency-State Agreement  
for Federal-Aid Projects No. 10-5940 will provide funding for the  
rehabilitation of the Darrah Road Bridge at West Fork Chowchilla  
River, #40C-0033, (PW No. 93-17); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Mariposa County desires to  
implement these improvements, and execution of the Program  
Supplement with the California Department of Transportation is  
required to receive Federal Aid for the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the  
County of Mariposa, that Michael D. Edwards, Director of Public  
Works, is hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of  
Mariposa County Program Supplement 014 and all other necessary  
documents to implement and carry out the purposes of this  
resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of  
Mariposa, that Mariposa County stipulates as a condition to payment  
of funds obligated to this project, that it accepts and will comply  
with the covenants or remarks set forth on page 2 of 2, "Special  
Covenants or Remarks", attached to Program Supplement No. 014.



SPECIAL COVENANTS OR REMARKS

1. All maintenance, involving the physical condition and the operation of the improvements, referred to in Article VI MAINTENANCE of the aforementioned Master Agreement will be performed by the Local Agency and/or the respective agencies as determined by agreement at regular intervals or as required for efficient operation of the completed improvements.
2. The Local Agency will advertise, award, and administer this project and will obtain the State's concurrence prior to either award or rejection of the contract.
3. The Local Agency agrees the payment of Federal funds will be limited to the amounts approved by the Federal Highway Administration in the Federal-Aid Project Agreement (PR-2)/Detail Estimate or its modification (PR-2A) or the FNM-76, and accepts any increases in Exchange Funds, State Matching funds, and/or Local Agency Funds as shown on the Finance or Bid Letter or its modification as prepared by the Division of Local Streets and Roads.
4. In executing this Program Supplemental Agreement, Local Agency hereby reaffirms the "Nondiscrimination Assurances" contained in the aforementioned Master Agreement for Federal-Aid Program.
5. Whenever the local agency uses a consultant on a cost plus basis, the local agency is required to submit a post audit report covering the allowability of cost payments for each individual consultant or sub-contractor incurring over \$25,000 on the project. The audit report must state the applicable cost principles utilized by the auditor in determining allowable costs as referenced in CFR 49, part 18, Subpart C - 22, Allowable Costs.
