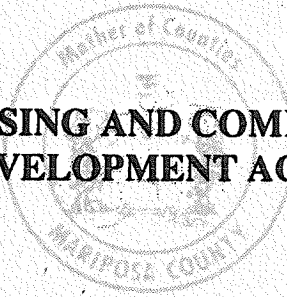

SUBJECT: DOE Weatherization Program

In the past, Mariposa County has implemented two weatherization programs: Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) and the Department of Energy Program. Both are similar in eligibility and work to be performed.

According to the 1990 Census, there are an estimated 1,500 eligible renter and owner households in the County (incomes less than 150% of the Federal Poverty Level). To date, 753 housing units have been weatherized. 72 units are "backlogged" awaiting weatherization services.

Units that have been weatherized before 1989 are eligible for "re-weatherization". However, "re-weatherized" units are eligible only for new energy conservation measures designed to reduce infiltration and increase energy efficiency. Less than 20 housing units have been "re-weatherized" to date.
