Authorize the Public Works Director to execute documents for the Allocation Request for Clean Air Act (Proposition 116) Bicycle Funds for Bus and Bus Stop Bike Racks

The requested \$ 6,000 of Prop. 116 Bicycle Funds will be used for installation of up to nine bike racks for buses, and up to three bike racks to be installed at bus stops, both for the use of commuters.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

The Board approved an application for Clean Air Act Bike funds for bike racks on November 11, 1992. The California Transportation Commission (CTC) approved the application on June 1, 1994. The racks cannot be purchased by the County for the buses until the Allocation Request is submitted by the County and approved by the CTC.
