**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE OCJP GRANT AWARD AGREEMENT
CONCERNING THE VICTIM/WITNESS ASSISTANCE PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Mariposa County District Attorney desires to undertake a certain project, designated as the Victim/Witness Program, to be funded in part from funds made available through the Victim/Witness Assistance Program administered by the Office of Criminal Justice Planning, hereinafter referred to as the OCJP.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mariposa County District Attorney is hereby authorized to submit the attached proposal to the OCJP and the Chairman of the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized to execute the attached Grant Award Agreement, including any extensions or amendments thereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the applicant, Mariposa County, agrees to provide all matching funds required for said project, including any extensions or amendments thereof, as set forth in the program and funding terms and conditions of the OCJP and that the case match will be appropriated as required.

IT IS AGREED that any public liability arising out of the performance of this Grant Award Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the authorizing agency. The State of California and the OCJP disclaim any responsibility for any such liability.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all grant funds received pursuant to the attached Grant Award Agreement shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
