A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THOMAS NICHOLAS SUBIAS AS SALUTATORIAN OF THE 1993 GRADUATING CLASS OF MARIPOSA COUNTY HIGH SCHOOL

WHEREAS, THOMAS SUBIAS has been on the Honor Roll and a member of the California Scholarship Federation all four years at Mariposa High. His academic excellence has merited him an Air Force Math and Science Award, the Outstanding Achievement in Foreign Language Award for Spanish IV, an Achievement in Math Award for Calculus, an Outstanding Achievement in Science Three Year Lab Award, and a Senior Class Outstanding English Student Award; and,

WHEREAS, THOMAS was selected as the outstanding Science/Math student at Mariposa High School, earning him the honor of receiving the Bank of America Plaque in Science/Math.
