

1 MARIPOSA COUNTY RESOLUTION No. 83-346

2 ESTABLISHING A
3 COURTHOUSE TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION FUND
4 PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE § 68073.6

5 WHEREAS, the County of Mariposa is in need of
6 additional funding for the acquisition, rehabilitation,
7 construction, and financing of courtrooms, a courtroom
8 building or buildings containing facilities necessary to the
9 operation of the Courts, and

10 WHEREAS, assessments pursuant to paragraph 2(a) of
11 Section 1206.8 of the Penal Code are necessary to the
12 establishment of adequate courtroom facilities in Mariposa
13 County, and

14 WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens
15 of Mariposa County to levy assessments on criminal fines
16 pursuant to Section 1206.8 of the Penal Code;

17 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of
18 Supervisors of Mariposa County, a political subdivision of
19 the State of California as follows:

20 1. The provisions of Government Code Section
21 68073.6 and Penal Code Section 1206.8, paragraph 2(a) are
22 hereby adopted; which provides that assessments upon

23 (a) parking offenses, and

24 (b) fine, penalty, or forfeiture imposed and
25 collected by the Courts for criminal offenses, including all
26 offenses involving a violation of the Vehicle Code or any
27 local ordinance adopted pursuant to the Vehicle Code, except
28 offenses relating to parking or registration, or offenses by
pedestrians or bicyclists, or where an order is made to pay

1 a sum to the General Fund of the County pursuant to Paragraph
2 (iii) of Subdivision 3, of Section 258 of the Welfare and
3 Institutions Code, said assessments shall be collected by the
4 County Treasurer as provided below.

5 (i) There shall be levied on each parking
6 offense a surcharge of One Dollar and Fifty Cents (\$1.50), which
7 shall be included in the fine and forfeiture, and

8 (ii) There shall be levied on all offenses
9 described in Section 1206.08 paragraph 2(a) of the Penal Code,
10 the additional amount of One Dollar (\$1.00) for every Ten
11 Dollars (\$10.00) or fraction thereof, which shall be collected
12 together with, and in the same manner as, the assessment
13 established by Section 1464 of the Penal Code.

14 (iii) The above amount shall be deposited
15 with the County Treasurer and placed in the fund established
16 pursuant to Section 68073.6 of the Government Code.

17 2. The County Auditor and County Treasurer shall
18 create a fund to be known as the "Courthouse Temporary
19 Construction Fund", and said Fund shall be held by the Treasurer
20 separate from any funds subject to transfer or division pur-
21 suant to Section 1463 of the Penal Code. The monies of the
22 Courthouse Temporary Construction Fund shall be payable only
23 for acquisition, rehabilitation, construction and financing
24 of courtrooms, a courtroom building or buildings, containing
25 facilities necessary to the operation of the Courts.

26 3. Deposits to the Courthouse Temporary Construction
27 Fund shall continue through and including either:
