

1 MARIPOSA COUNTY RESOLUTION 82-14

2 A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE
3 MARIPOSA COUNTY COMMISSION ON AGING

4 RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of
5 Mariposa, State of California, that:

6 RESOLUTIONS 78-169, 79-203 and 82-13 are hereby re-
7 scinded and superseded.

8 WHEREAS, this Board is concerned with the increasing
9 problems and opportunities faced by the aging and the aged in all
10 phases of community life and desires to establish better means of
11 communication with such persons in order to better understand the
12 problems and opportunities they face; and

13 WHEREAS, this Board deems it desirable to form the
14 Mariposa County Commission on Aging, composed of persons appointed
15 by this Board, as a means of providing better communication be-
16 tween the aging and the aged and the balance of the community, and
17 as an instrument that may assist such persons in taking advantage
18 of available opportunities in finding solutions to community prob-
19 lems which may affect them.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, this Board hereby determines and orders
21 as follows:

22 1. The Mariposa County Commission on Aging is hereby
23 established and shall be composed of five members.

24 2. The individual members of the Commission shall be
25 nominated by the Supervisor from each supervisorial district and
26 shall be appointed by the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors.

27 3. No member of the Commission shall receive reimburse-
28 ment for any mileage, travel, or other expenses incurred in the

1 performance of duties as a member of said Commission without the
2 express approval of this Board.

3 4. The Commission will act in an advisory capacity to
4 this Board in the general area of problems faced by the aging and
5 the aged in the County of Mariposa.

6 5. The Commission shall formulate and transmit in writ-
7 ing to this Board statements of the problems facing the aging and
8 aged in the community, as determined by the Commission, and may
9 propose suggestions for the solutions to such problems.

10 6. The Commission shall have its first meeting at the
11 call of the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors; it may elect its
12 own officers and adopt rules for the conduct of its own business
13 including a determination of the number of its members necessarily
14 present in order to constitute a quorum.

15 7. The term of each person appointed to the Mariposa
16 County Commission on Aging shall correspond to the term of the
17 Supervisor nominating said person for appointment and shall termi-
18 nate when said Supervisor leaves office for any reason, or com-
19 mences a new term in office.
