

1 MARIPOSA COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 82-52  
2 A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE PIONEER WAGON TRAIN  
3 AS AN OFFICIAL COUNTY-SPONSORED ACTIVITY

4 WHEREAS Mariposa County is the scene for a traditional  
5 event known as the Pioneer Wagon Train Ride; and

6 WHEREAS the Board of Supervisors desires that Mariposa  
7 County sponsor said event in view of its historical signifi-  
8 cance to the County of Mariposa;

9 NOW THEREFORE it is resolved by the Board of Supervisors  
10 of Mariposa County as follows:

11 1. The County of Mariposa shall sponsor the Pioneer  
12 Wagon Train Ride event for 1982 as an official Mariposa County  
13 activity;

14 2. The County of Mariposa shall provide limited sponsor-  
15 ship including such insurance coverage, police control, and  
16 clearing of the roadways as may be practical and reasonable  
17 under the circumstances;

18 3. The Bailment Agreement as amended and attached hereto  
19 as Exhibit "A" is hereby approved by the Mariposa County Board  
20 of Supervisors.

## BAILMENT AGREEMENT

This agreement is by and between the National Park Service, U. S. Department of the Interior, at Yosemite National Park, hereinafter called "Park", and Mariposa County Chamber of Commerce, hereinafter called "Chamber".

The Park agrees to lend a stagecoach to the Chamber on June 11, 1982, under the following terms and conditions:

1. The parties hereto shall inspect the coach at Wawona before and after it is lent as described above.
2. The parties hereto agree that the replacement value of the coach is in the amount of Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000.00).
3. The Chamber will be permitted to draw the coach from Wawona to Mariposa by a team of horses, but at the discretion of the Chamber, may transport the coach by truck or trailer for all or part of the distance.
4. The Chamber will return the coach to the Park on or before June 15, 1982.
5. The Chamber assumes liability for damage to or loss of the coach during the time the coach is in its bailment, and will cause insurance to be maintained to cover any such damage or loss to the coach.
6. The Chamber agrees that repair or replacement of any damage incurred during the said bailment shall be done at the Wagon Shop of the Park, at the expense of the Chamber.
7. If the coach is damaged, or not returned to the Park on or before June 15, 1982, the Chamber will agree to liquidate damages to the Park in the amount of Forty Dollars (\$40.00) per day until the coach is repaired or returned, but not to exceed 33 days.

8. A condition Precedent to the execution of this agreement is approval by the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors.
