

1 MARIPOSA COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 82-74

2 A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE FIFTH ANNUAL BUTTERFLY DAYS
3 PARADE AS AN OFFICIAL MARIPOSA COUNTY ACTIVITY

4 The Board of Supervisors of Mariposa County does hereby
5 resolve as follows:

6 WHEREAS, Mariposa will hold its Sixth Annual Butterfly
7 Days Celebration with a parade on June 12, 1982, at approximately
8 2:00 p.m. starting at the Mariposa Creek Bridge on Highway 140
9 and proceeding up Highway 140 to a termination point at approxi-
10 mately the intersection of Highway 140 and 12th Street; and,

11 WHEREAS, vehicular traffic and other traffic may be diverted
12 so as not to interfere with said parade and community gathering
13 in the town of Mariposa and without inconvenience to the travel-
14 ing public and the persons using said highway and streets; and,

15 WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires that the County
16 of Mariposa adopt the parade portion of the Butterfly days
17 celebration as an official Mariposa County activity;

18 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors
19 of Mariposa County hereby adopts the Sixth Annual Butterfly Days
20 Parade as an official Mariposa County activity on June 12, 1982
21 as described hereinabove.


22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mariposa County Chamber of
23 Commerce shall act as the authorized agent of Mariposa County for
24 the limited specific purpose of supervising, directing and con-
25 trolling the Sixth Annual Butterfly Days Parade on June 12, 1982,
26 in the town of Mariposa, and may employ such volunteers for that
27 purpose as it shall officially designate in written notice to
28 Mariposa County; said agent is authorized to apply for permits

1 and permission from other public entities as required for said
2 parade, on behalf of Mariposa County.


3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mariposa County Sheriff
4 shall coordinate with the California Highway Patrol for the
5 necessary traffic direction in accordance with public safety
6 and the permits and regulations required for such parade.
