

1 MARIPOSA COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 82-199

2 A RESOLUTION REQUESTING CONTINUED STATE AIR RESOURCES  
3 BOARD SUBVENTION TO LOCAL DISTRICTS

4 WHEREAS, local air pollution control districts are essential to the  
5 attainment and maintenance of State and National Ambient Air Quality Standards;  
6 and

7 WHEREAS, such attainment and maintenance of standards reduces costs  
8 to the citizens of California by protecting the public health and enhancing  
9 the production of agricultural commodities; and

10 WHEREAS, the citizens of California individually contribute approximately  
11 one half of the air pollution by the use of their private vehicles; and

12 WHEREAS, locally generated revenue from county contributions and fees  
13 accounts for more than 70% of all district revenue in California while subven-  
14 tion provides less than 20%; and

15 WHEREAS, excessive funding from fees is desirable to avoid District  
16 dependence on regulated industry and avoid the substantial adverse economic  
17 impact on industry; and

18 WHEREAS, the loss of local air quality control programs will result in  
19 substantial costs to the State to conduct such programs in the place of the  
20 local district; and

21 WHEREAS, the State Legislature has established within the Air Resources  
22 Board a subvention program to assure the continued effective operation of  
23 local air pollution control districts; and

24 WHEREAS, there is adequate funding available from the State Motor Vehicle  
25 Account and other revenue accounts to continue this program.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mariposa County Board of Super-  
27 visors that the Governor, the State Legislature, the Air Resources Board,  
28 the State Department of Finance, and the Legislative Analyst are hereby

1 requested to continue to fund the Air Pollution Control Subvention Program  
2 at at least the same level as in previous years.

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that such funding should be from the State  
4 Motor Vehicle Account or other appropriate special fund accounts.
