

1 MARIPOSA COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 82-211

2 A RESOLUTION SUPERCEDING RES. NO. 78-185  
3 ESTABLISHING THE ADVISORY BOARD ON ALCOHOL PROBLEMS  
4 TO ADD THE FUNCTIONS OF THE DRUG ABUSE BOARD

5 WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the Board of Supervi-  
6 sors of the County of Mariposa, State of California, recognize  
7 the importance of the establishment of an Alcohol and Drug  
8 Abuse Advisory Board; and,

9 WHEREAS, there is a need for encouragement of the planning,  
10 establishing, and conducting of county programs in alcoholism  
11 and drug abuse prevention, treatment, and rehabilitation.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mariposa County Board  
13 of Supervisors that an Alcohol/Drug Abuse Advisory Board be  
14 established under the following guidelines:

15 MEMBERSHIP

16 Board shall consist of not less than seven nor more than  
17 15 members, with representation from various economic,  
18 social, and occupational groups, and persons who have  
19 received treatment or rehabilitation services for their  
20 alcoholism problems.

21 MEETINGS

22 The Advisory Board shall meet at least bimonthly and may  
23 meet at such other times as may be deemed necessary by the  
24 Chairman or alcoholism administrator. Members shall serve  
25 without compensation, but shall be reimbursed for any actual  
26 and necessary expenses incurred in connection with their  
27 duties under Chapter 19929 of SB 744.

28 TERMS AND MANNER OF APPOINTMENT

Members shall be appointed for a term of three years. As

1 scheduled and unscheduled vacancies occur, a notice will  
2 be posted by the Clerk of the Board soliciting candidates  
3 for appointment. Appointees will be selected from the  
4 applicants and appointed to the Advisory Board by the Board  
5 of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa.

6 COMMITTEE DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

7 The Advisory Board shall:

- 8 a. Review and evaluate the county program budget, and any  
9 amendments thereto, and the community's alcoholism and  
10 drug abuse prevention, treatment, and rehabilitation  
11 needs, services, facilities, and special problems, and  
12 may make onsite visits to such facilities and interview  
13 persons who have received aid from such facilities.  
14 b. Advise the county alcoholism and drug abuse administra-  
15 tor on policies, goals, and operations of the county  
16 alcoholism and drug abuse program and on any other  
17 related matters the alcoholism and drug abuse administra-  
18 tor refers to it or which are raised by the Advisory  
19 Board.  
20 c. Encourage public understanding of the problems of  
21 alcoholism and drug abuse and support throughout the  
22 county for development and implementation of effective  
23 alcoholism and drug abuse programs.
