

MARIPOSA COUNTY RESOLUTION No. 82-250

Modifying the County Holidays

RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors that Section 9 of the Personnel Policies and Procedures Handbook is amended to read as follows: (see attachment)

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the Memorandum of Understanding for Fiscal Year 1982-83 is hereby amended to add the following language, the Chairman is authorized to sign same:

"COUNTY HOLIDAYS

Martin Luther King, Jr. Day on January 15, shall be deleted from the list of County legal holidays, and shall become a day of recognition only. The optional holidays specified in paragraph 9.02.02 of the Personnel Policies and Procedures Handbook shall be expanded to include, for options "2" and "3" the following:

2. The working day before or the first working day after Christmas (December 25th),

3. The working day before or the first working day after New Year's Day (January 1st)."

SECTION 9: HOLIDAYS

9.01 LEGAL HOLIDAYS

The following are hereby established as legal holidays in the County of Mariposa pursuant to Government Code Sections 6700, 18025, and 18025.1:

1. Every Sunday;
2. January 1st;
3. February 12th known as "Lincoln Day";
4. Third Monday in February;
5. Last Monday in May;
6. July 4th;
7. First Monday in September;
8. September 9th known as "Admission Day";
9. Second Monday in October known as "Columbus Day";
10. November 11th known as "Veterans Day";
11. December 25th;
12. Every day appointed by the President or Governor for a public fast, thanksgiving, or holiday, provided each such day is specified as a paid holiday by the President or Governor for public employees. The Thursday in November appointed as Thanksgiving Day shall be a legal holiday in Mariposa County;
13. Every employee shall be entitled to take as a holiday the Friday preceding any Saturday on which one of the holidays set out in subsections 2, 3, 6, 8, 10 and 11 above occurs;
14. Every employee shall be entitled to take as a holiday the Monday following any Sunday on which one of the holidays set out in subsections 2, 3, 6, 8, 10 and 11 above occurs;
15. January 15th, known as "Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day" shall be a day of recognition only and shall not be a legal holiday for any other purpose.

9.02 PERSONAL HOLIDAYS

9.02.01 Personal Holiday

Every employee shall be entitled to one personal holiday per calendar year pursuant to Government Code Section 18025.1.

9.02.02 Additional Holiday

Every employee shall be entitled to take one of the following additional holidays, subject to the employee's choice and prior approval by the employee's department head:

1. The day after Thanksgiving;
2. The working day before or the first working day after Christmas (December 25th);
3. The working day before or the first working day after New Year's Day (January 1st).
