2 A RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING GIRL SCOUT WEEK

3 PROCLAMATION

4 WHEREAS, Girl Scouts of the U.S.A. observes the 69th anniver-
5 sary of its founding on March 12, 1981; and

6 WHEREAS, this organization of nearly three million girls
7 and adults was founded by a woman to suit what she saw as the
8 needs of girls; and

9 WHEREAS, this organization, not content with the safe and
10 sure, the tried and true, but aware of the changing needs and pri-
11 orities of our technological age, has kept itself flexible and
12 contemporaneous; and

13 WHEREAS, the Girl Scouts not only are dedicated to implement-
14 ing the felt needs of girls and women, beginning with its youngest
15 members, but anticipate those needs where possible; and

16 WHEREAS, the Girl Scouts looking to the future, stress career
17 exploration and awareness, as well as job development, as a means
18 of fulfilling the potential of all women, benefiting not only them-
19 selves but all of society; and

20 WHEREAS, Girl Scout Week will be observed by the Girl Scouts
21 of our community from March 8 through March 14 by celebrating
22 "Girl Scouting 1980s Style,"

23 NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved by the Board of Supervi-
24 sors of Mariposa County that the week of March 8 through March 14,
25 1981 is hereby proclaimed GIRL SCOUT WEEK in Mariposa County;

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors does
27 hereby call upon all citizens of Mariposa County to give their
28 continued interest, cooperation, and support to the Girl Scouts and


