

1 MARIPOSA COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 81-90  
2 A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE FIFTH ANNUAL BUTTERFLY DAYS  
3 PARADE AS AN OFFICIAL MARIPOSA COUNTY ACTIVITY

4 The Board of Supervisors of Mariposa County does hereby  
5 resolve as follows:

6 WHEREAS, Mariposa will hold its Fifth Annual Butterfly Days  
7 Celebration with a parade on June 13, 1981, at approximately  
8 2:00 p.m. starting at the Mariposa Creek Bridge on Highway 140  
9 and proceeding up Highway 140 to a termination point at approxi-  
10 mately the intersection of Highway 140 and 12th Street; and

11 WHEREAS, vehicular traffic and other traffic may be diverted  
12 so as not to interfere with said parade and community gathering  
13 the town of Mariposa and without inconvenience to the traveling  
14 public and the persons using said highway and streets; and

15 WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires that the County of  
16 Mariposa adopt the parade portion of the Butterfly days celebration  
17 as an official Mariposa County activity;

18 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of  
19 Mariposa County hereby adopts the Fifth Annual Butterfly Days  
20 Parade as an official Mariposa County activity on June 13, 1981, as  
21 described hereinabove.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mariposa County Chamber of  
23 Commerce shall act as the authorized agent of Mariposa County for  
24 the limited specific purpose of supervising, directing and control-  
25 ing the Fifth Annual Butterfly Days Parade on June 13, 1981, in the  
26 town of Mariposa, and may employ such volunteers for that purpose  
27 as it shall officially designate in written notice to Mariposa  
28 County; said agent is authorized to apply for permits and permis-  
sion from other public entities as required for said parade, on be-

1 half of Mariposa County.

2 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mariposa County Sheriff shall  
3 coordinate with the California Highway Patrol for the necessary  
4 traffic direction in accordance with public safety and the permits  
5 and regulations required for such parade.
