

1 MARIPOSA COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 81-130

2 A RESOLUTION REESTABLISHING A COUNTY
3 SAFETY PROGRAM AND COMMITTEE

4 BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Mariposa County
5 as follows:

6 1. There shall be immediately formed a Mariposa County
7 Safety Program to provide for the training of County employees and
8 the periodic safety inspection of the worksites and work methods
9 of County departments.

10 2. The Mariposa County Safety Committee shall be com-
11 posed of five members, each representing a separate department,
12 which shall be appointed by the Board from among the following de-
13 partments:

- 14 a. Sheriff's Office
15 b. Road Department
16 c. Parks and Recreation
17 d. Volunteer Fire Departments
18 e. Solid Waste
19 f. Maintenance
20 g. Other clerical-type departments as one group.

21 3. Staff support shall be provided by the County Counsel
22 and his staff and others as may from time to time be needed. Con-
23 sultants from County insurance administrators may be utilized upon
24 Board approval.

25 4. The designated representative of the employees' asso-
26 ciation shall be invited to all meetings and inspections.

27 5. The purposes of the Committee shall be to regularly
28 review all County operations to help eliminate unsafe working con-

1 ditions and formulate training recommendations.

2 6. Functions of the Committee shall be:

- 3 a. To conduct an annual safety inspection of all
4 County departments utilizing work accident
injury reports and past recommendations;
- 5 b. To meet monthly for up to two hours for the
6 purpose of discussing departmental safety pro-
grams and problems with each department head
7 or chief officer;
- 8 c. To review accidents, injuries, claims and com-
9 plaints for the purpose of formulating safety
recommendations.
- 10 d. To prepare a periodic report of findings and
recommendations to the Board of Supervisors.


11 7. An annual inspection of all County departments shall
12 be conducted between July 1, and October 1, of each year by the
13 Committee. The inspection shall examine working environments of
14 County employees and shall be conducted in such a manner as to
15 minimize interference with operations as possible. The purpose of
16 the inspection shall be to identify locations and activities posing
17 risk of injury to County employees and to formulate recommendations
18 to reduce or eliminate risk.
