

MARIPOSA COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 81-165

3 BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of
4 Mariposa County, a political subdivision of the State of Calif-
5 ornia, that the Constitution of the United States of America gives
6 us the foundation for a free, prosperous and independent life for
7 every citizen, but each generation, in turn, must work for and
8 claim it; otherwise, through carelessness or indifference, the
9 rights and liberties we have enjoyed may vanish; and,

10 WHEREAS, it is the greatest consequence that the citi-
11 zens fully understand the provisions and principles contained in
12 the Constitution of the United States of America in order to be
13 able to support it properly as, "The greatest document for human
14 liberty in two thousand years of recorded history;" and

15 WHEREAS, the people of the United States should be deep-
16 ly grateful to their Founding Fathers for the wisdom and foresight
17 they displayed in writing and adopting the Constitution.

18 The independence granted to the American people to en-
19 joy such freedom and liberty, unknown to any other country, should
20 be celebrated by appropriate ceremonies and activities during
21 Constitution Week, September 17 through 23, as designated by pro-
22 clamation of the President of the United States in accordance
23 with Public Law No. 915,

24 NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of the County
25 of Mariposa, do hereby proclaim the week of September 17 through
26 23 of each year as CONSTITUTION WEEK and urge all citizens to
27 study the Constitution, to express gratitude for the privilege of
