A G R E E M E N T

MARIPOSA EMERGENCY RESCUE UNIT

This Agreement is entered into this 6th day of October, 1981, between the COUNTY OF MARIPOSA, a political subdivision of the State of California, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY", MARIPOSA PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT, hereinafter referred to as "MPUD", and the Mariposa Public Utility District Volunteer Fire Department, hereinafter referred to as "VOLUNTEERS".

WHEREAS, the parties hereto enter into this agreement to facilitate the delivery of rescue services in Mariposa County.

NOW THEREFORE it is agreed as follows:

1. PURPOSE. The purpose of this agreement is to establish an Emergency Rescue Unit to respond to rescue and general fire fighting situations in Mariposa County.

2. DESCRIPTION OF UNIT. A special emergency vehicle owned by COUNTY and equipped with rescue equipment, the "Jaws of Life" and fire fighting equipment, manned and operated by trained members of the Mariposa County fire system under the direction and control of COUNTY Fire Warden or persons authorized by said Warden.

3. VOLUNTEERS agree to donate, with the assistance of MPUD, the following described vehicle, and the equipment described in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein, to COUNTY subject to the conditions set forth hereafter:

1971 CHEVROLET VAN TYPE VEHICLE

4. MPUD agrees to donate to COUNTY the sum of THIRTEEN HUNDRED DOLLARS toward the purchase of said vehicle and equipment, subject to the conditions set forth herein, and to permit said

1 vehicle to be stationed and dispatched from MPUD premises, with
2 access to said vehicle by COUNTY.

3 5. COUNTY agrees to accept, license, maintain and insure
4 said vehicle and equipment to be used exclusively for the purposes
5 described herein.

6 6. CONDITIONS: The parties hereby mutually agree that the
7 gifts and donations described herein shall be subject to the fol-
8 lowing conditions:

9 A. Said rescue vehicle shall be available and respond to
10 rescue and fire situations within the boundaries of MPUD as well
11 as the COUNTY in general, at the discretion and direction of the
12 COUNTY Fire Warden or persons authorized by said Warden.

13 B. Said rescue vehicle shall be permanently stationed
14 within the community of Mariposa as defined by the Mariposa Town
15 Planning Area.

16 C. In the event of response situations occurring both in
17 the general COUNTY area and within MPUD at the same time, the vehi-
18 cle shall respond to all such calls at the discretion and direction
19 of the COUNTY Fire Warden or persons authorized by said Warden.

20 D. In the event that trained members of the Mariposa
21 County fire system who respond to an emergency call are also mem-
22 bers of MPUD Volunteer Fire Department, those such individuals
23 transported to such emergency scene in the emergency rescue vehicle
24 described herein, for the purpose of operating the vehicle and the
25 equipment on said vehicle, shall be deemed COUNTY volunteers under
26 COUNTY direction and control for purposes of insurance, workers
27 compensation and liability.

28 7. BREACH OR TERMINATION. In the event that any of the con-

1 ditions set forth herein are breached or the Emergency Rescue Unit
2 is terminated, the vehicle described herein shall become the prop-
3 erty of MPUD and the equipment listed on Exhibit A shall also be-
4 come the property of MPUD.
