

MARIPOSA COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 81-194

RESOLUTION RELATIVE TO THE DECLARATION AND RECOGNITION OF
ED SACKETT AS A NATIVE SON OF COULTERVILLE, MARIPOSA COUNTY, CA

WHEREAS, the late ED SACKETT was the proprietor of
Coulterville's famous Jeffrey Hotel and Magnolia Room
(a quality saloon of good reputation) for more than four
decades and until July, 1975, when ED SACKETT passed on to
his reward and well-deserved rest; and,

WHEREAS, ED SACKETT operated numerous business
enterprises throughout the community thereby creating a stable
and favorable climate for business opportunity, provided
employment to the industrious, and shelter and comfort for
some who otherwise would have had none; and,

WHEREAS, ED SACKETT's continuous attention to pre-
serving the past, and building and planning for Coulterville's
future projected a general sense of prosperity and well-being
to residents and visitors to Coulterville; and,

WHEREAS, ED SACKETT was a kind and modest man, known
by thousands of natives and international visitors for the
hospitality famous throughout the friendly mountain villages
of the Sierras, and truly was Coulterville and Mariposa
County's best known good-will ambassador; and,


WHEREAS, ED SACKETT was respected as a shrewd business
man and entrepreneur with no equal, he was also a very private
person, a man of deep and compassionate feelings, and was
on occasion heard to lament, "I've been here over 40 years and
I guess I'll be known as that damn flatlander from L.A. until
the day I die."

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mariposa
2 County Board of Supervisors finds it is a fitting tribute to
3 recognize ED SACKETT's outstanding contributions to his
4 community and visitors to Mariposa County and does hereby
5 declare and order that hereafter and in perpetuity ED SACKETT
6 be known to all men as a NATIVE SON of Coulterville,
7 Mariposa, CA; and,


8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a suitable commemorative
9 plaque be prepared and installed in close proximity of the
10 shade tree to be planted in the Coulterville Community Park
11 in memory of ED SACKETT, NATIVE SON.
