A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE SALARY RESOLUTION

RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Mariposa County, a political subdivision of the State of California, that the Mariposa County Salary Resolution No. 81-129 is hereby amended as follows:

1. The Employee Allocation Schedule, Exhibit A-1, is amended on page 1, item "G" to delete "1 Counselor/Monitor 102-118" from the CETA Program Office.

2. The Employee Allocation Schedule, Exhibit A-1, is amended to add to page 4 under Hourly Personnel Positions the following positions:

3. The Employee Allocation Schedule, Exhibit A-1, is amended on page 1 to delete the Range of 138-154 from item "G", CETA Program Administrator and add the range 125-141 for that same position.

5. This Resolution shall be effective as of October 1, 1981.
