

1 MARIPOSA COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 77-72

3 The Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa do  
4 hereby resolve as follows:

5 WHEREAS, the work of a Mariposa County Overall Economic  
6 Development Program Committee is recognized, since its formal  
7 inception in 1966, as very beneficial;

8 WHEREAS, in consideration of consistent high unemployment  
9 and low per capita income the County qualifies as a Title IV  
10 Redevelopment Area under the Public Works and Economic Development  
11 Act of 1965;

12 WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors is interested in  
13 sponsoring and supporting programs to increase employment and  
14 other economic opportunity for County residents;

15 WHEREAS, it is desirable such sponsorship and support be  
16 given organized effort of broad geographic and varied economic  
17 interest representation, and;

18 WHEREAS, there is need for ideas, planning, and co-  
19 operation in implementation and promotion of economic development  
20 efforts responsive to private economic as well as public, profess-  
21 ional, or political interests; now, therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED that the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors  
23 hereby reaffirms its approval of Mariposa County Overall Economic  
24 Development Program Committee and in support thereof will continue  
25 to appoint a Coordinator and an executive committee of five, one  
26 appointed by each member of the Board. This Committee to be res-  
27 ponsible for organization, administration, and function of full  
28 Committee which may be composed of representatives of organizations,

1 individual businesses, public officials, or any interested adult  
2 residents of the county; and be it further

3 RESOLVED that each member of the Board will appoint one  
4 additional regular member to the Committee who will also act as  
5 alternate executive committeeperson; and be it further

6 RESOLVED that the Committee is charged specifically with  
7 the responsibility of developing O. E. D. P. Plan and reporting  
8 the progress of such plan in such form and at such intervals as  
9 may be required for the County to remain eligible for financial  
10 assistance under the Public Works and Economic Development Act of  
11 1965, and generally of cooperating with all government programs  
12 designed to improve economic conditions.

13 PASSED AND ADOPTED at a regular meeting of the Board of  
14 Supervisors of the County of Mariposa held on this 24th  
15 day of May, 1977, by the following vote:


