RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF MARIPOSA ADOPTING A CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE AS AMENDED BY THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA FAIR POLITICAL PRACTICES COMMISSION PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 87103(b).

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa hereby resolve as follows:

SECTION I: ADOPTION OF CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE.

In compliance with Section 87300 of the Government Code, the Board of Supervisors hereby adopts this amended Conflict of Interest Code.

SECTION 2: APPLICATION OF CODE.

This Conflict of Interest Code shall be applicable to members of the County Board of Supervisors, whether acting as board members or as members of any county board or commission.

SECTION 3: DISCLOSURE.

Members of the Board of Supervisors are required, pursuant to Government Code Section 87200, to disclose investments, interest in real property and income. No other or no additional disclosure requirements are imposed by this Conflict of Interest Code.

SECTION 4: CIRCUMSTANCES REQUIRING DISQUALIFICATION.

Any member of the Board of Supervisors, whether acting as a board member or as governing board member or commissioner of any County agency must disqualify himself or herself from making

1 or participating in the making of any decisions which will fore-
 2 seeably have a material financial effect, distinguishable from its
 3 effect on the public generally, on any economic interest, as
 4 defined in Government Code Section 87103. No member shall be
 5 prevented from making or participating in the making of any
  decision to the extent his or her participation is legally re-
  quired for the decision to be made.
