RIGHT OF WAY CERTIFICATE

The County of Mariposa hereby certifies in connection with the right-of-way for the Indian Peak Road Bridge at the West Fork of the Chowchilla River, 10-MPA-OS-043(1) that:

All required right-of-way for construction of this project has now been acquired as set forth in detail below:

1. STATUS OF RIGHT OF WAY ACQUISITION

- a. Total number of parcels required - 1
- b. Total number of parcels acquired - 1

2. STATUS OF AFFECTED RAILROAD FACILITIES

- a. No facilities in the area.

3. DESIGNATED MATERIAL SITES

- a. Any material sites required will be located within the right of way.

4. DESIGNATED DISPOSAL SITES

- a. No disposal sites are required for this project.

5. STATUS OF UTILITY LOCATIONS

- a. No relocation of utilities are required. All utilities are located outside of the project limits.

6. SCHEDULE FOR REMOVAL OF OBSTRUCTIONS

- a. No obstructions need be removed for this project.

7. UNAUTHORIZED ENCROACHMENTS

- a. No unauthorized encroachments exist on this project.

8. COMPLIANCE WITH FEDERAL AND STATE REQUIREMENTS REGARDING THE ACQUISITION OF REAL PROPERTY

- a. All right of way has been acquired in accordance with Title III of the Federal Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970 (Public Law 91-646).

9. COMPLIANCE WITH RELOCATION ADVISORY ASSISTANCE AND PAYMENTS PROVISIONS OF FEDERAL AND STATE LAW

- a. Compliance with the provisions of PPM 81-1 was not required for this project. No dwellings, farm operations or businesses will be displaced by this project.

The County of Mariposa agrees to hold the State of California harmless for any liability which may result in the event the right of way is not clear as certified. If the State is named in a damage suit, as a result of the right of way not being clear as certified, the County of Mariposa agrees that, at the request of the State, it will assume full responsibility for the conduct of the defense or provide such assistance as the State may require in connection with the defense.
