10 Department employees compensated at an hourly rate, shall be paid  
11 monthly according to the following 8-step salary range classifi-  
12 cation plan, with each employee entering employment at the first  
13 step of the salary range classification provided for his or her  
14 employment or such step thereof as the Board of Supervisors shall  
15 by minute order designate at or after the time of hiring, to wit:

40 hour work week from the following classifications:


