

MARIPOSA COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 75-138

CALLING A PUBLIC HEARING TO DETERMINE WHETHER PUBLIC NECESSITY, HEALTH, SAFETY, OR WELFARE REQUIRES THE FORMATION OF AN UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT ON CERTAIN LANDS IN THE TOWNSITE OF MARIPOSA.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa as follows:

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 333 establishes a procedure for the creation of underground utility districts and requires as the initial step in such procedure the holding of a public hearing to ascertain whether public necessity, health, safety, or welfare requires the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, or similar or associated service in any such district; and

WHEREAS, it has been recommended that such an underground utility district, hereinafter called District, be formed on the lands legally described in the documents attached as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved as follows:

1. Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa on November 18, 1975, at the hour of 2:00 p.m., in the Board of Supervisors Room of the Courthouse, Mariposa, California, to ascertain whether the public necessity, health, safety or welfare requires the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, or

1 similar associated service in the District hereinabove described.

2 2. At such hearing, all persons interested shall be
3 given an opportunity to be heard. Said hearing may be continued
4 from time to time as may be determined by the Board of Supervi-
5 sors.

6 3. The County Clerk shall notify all affected property
7 owners as shown on the last equalized assessment roll and
8 utilities concerned of the time and place of such hearing by
9 mailing a copy of this resolution to such property owners and
10 utilities concerned at least ten (10) days prior to the date
11 thereof.

12 4. The area proposed to be included in the District is
13 shown upon that certain map entitled Underground Utility District,
14 dated July 1974, which is on display in the office of the County
15 Clerk of the County of Mariposa.

BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION OF:

UTILITY DISTRICT

All those portions of Blocks 17, 21, 22, 25 and 26 of the "Town of Mariposa" as said blocks are shown and designated on that certain map recorded as Map number 314 in the Office of the Recorder of Mariposa County, California, encompassed by the following described boundaries:

Beginning at the intersection of the centerline of Charles Street with the centerline of Fifth Street; thence, from said point of beginning, northeasterly along the centerline of Fifth Street, 301 feet more or less to the intersection with the centerline of Bullion Street; thence, northwesterly along the centerline of Bullion Street, 410 feet more or less to the intersection of the prolongation of the ^{the} southeasterly line of Conley property as described by deed recorded in Volume 134 of Official Records of Mariposa County at Page 304; thence, southwesterly along said prolongation and the various courses of said southeasterly line of the Conley property to the northeasterly line of the Beeman lot as described by deed recorded in Volume 138 of Official Records of Mariposa County at Page 604; thence, northwesterly 30 feet more or less to the most northerly corner of the said Beeman property; thence, southwesterly along the northwesterly line of said Beeman property and the

prolongation thereof to the centerline of Charles Street; thence, northwesterly along the centerline of Charles Street to the intersection of the northeasterly prolongation of the northwesterly line of the Garber property as described by deed recorded in Volume 15 of Official Records of Mariposa County at Page 440; thence, southwesterly along said line, 211 feet more or less to the most southerly corner of the Boeck property as described in the instrument recorded in Volume 32 of Official Records of Mariposa County at Page 322; thence, northwesterly, a distance of 81.2 feet more or less to a point on the westerly line of the Boeck property and the southeasterly line of Seventh Street; thence, southwesterly, along said southeasterly line of Seventh Street 88.9 feet more or less to the intersection of the centerline of Jessie Street; thence, in a southeasterly direction, a distance of 645 feet more or less to a point on said centerline that intersects with the prolongation of the southeasterly line of the James lot as described by deed recorded in Volume 126 of Official Records of Mariposa County at Page 554; thence, northeasterly 165 feet more or less along said lot line to a point at the northwesterly corner of the Trabucco property as described by deed recorded in Volume 48 of Official Records of Mariposa County at Page 191; thence, in a southeasterly direction

49 feet more or less to the southwest corner of said Trabucco property; thence, northeasterly, along the southeasterly line of said Trabucco property and the prolongation thereof, 135 feet more or less to the point of intersection with the centerline of Charles Street; thence, along said centerline in a northwesterly direction, a distance of 120 feet more or less to the point of beginning.
