



## RIGHT OF WAY CERTIFICATE

The County of Mariposa hereby certifies in connection with the right of way for the Greeley Hill Road Project, 10-MPA-965 CR, that all required right of way for construction of this project has now been acquired as set forth in detail below:

1. Status of Right of Way Acquisition.
  - a. Total number of parcels required - 5.
  - b. Total number of parcels acquired outright - 5.
2. Status of Affected Railroad Facilities.
  - a. No facilities in the area.
3. Designated Material Sites.
  - a. All material sites are within the acquired right of way.
4. Designated Disposal Sites.
  - a. No disposal sites required for this project.
5. Status of Utility Locations.
  - a. No relocation of utilities required.
6. Schedule for Removal of Obstructions.
  - a. No removal of obstructions required.
7. Unauthorized Encroachments.
  - a. No unauthorized encroachments exist on this project.
8. Compliance with Relocation Advisory Assistance and Payments Provisions of Federal and State Law.
  - a. Compliance with the provisions of IM-80-1-68 is not required for this project.
  - b. No dwellings, farm operations, or businesses will be displaced by this project.

The County of Mariposa Agrees to hold the State of California harmless from any liability which may result in the event the right of way is not clear as certified. If the State is named in a damage suit, as a result of the right of way not being clear as certified, the County of Mariposa agrees that, at the request of the State, it will assume full responsibility for the conduct of the defense or provide such assistance as the State may require and will pay judgments issued against the State and all costs in connection with the defense.
