4 WHEREAS, Norman Nichols, M.D., has presented his resigna-  
5 tion as Mariposa County Health Officer as of August 31, 1968, and

6 WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors and the citizens of  
7 Mariposa County have benefited materially from the knowledge and  
8 professional expertness of Norman Nichols, M.D., as County Health  
9 Officer, in many instances, such as --

- 10 (1) Established the Mental Health Clinic,  
11 (2) Instigated getting a filter system in connection  
12 with community water system,  
13 (3) Instrumental in providing community sewage disposal  
14 system,  
15 (4) Set policies of the Health Department,  
16 (5) Established a well organized health clinic,  
17 (6) Prescribed that the Supervisors annually look at  
18 garbage disposal sites,  
19 (7) Promoted passage of rabies control ordinance,  
20 (8) Served on Regional Health Planning Council of San  
21 Joaquin Valley and on many other health committees,  
22 (9) Developed and had ordinances passed for the safe  
23 handling of foods in public restaurants and eating  
24 places.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors  
26 of Mariposa County reluctantly accepts his resignation, and

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors com-  
28 mends and expresses its sincere gratitude to Norman Nichols, M.D.  
29 for his generous efforts, accomplishments and cooperation in  
30 directing orderly growth of Mariposa County.
