

1 BOARD OF SUPERVISORS - - COUNTY OF MARIPOSA

2 RESOLUTION NO. 68-89

3 WHEREAS, in California a tax subsidized college education is
4 a privilege for the individual student who passes certain entrance
5 requirements and who recognizes and accepts certain rules of con-
6 duct, which are the same for all students, regardless of race,
7 color or creed, and

8 WHEREAS, a tax supported college education is not a right to
9 be granted to members of minority groups, without regard to scholar-
10 ship or rules of conduct, only because they are members of minority
11 groups, and

12 WHEREAS, students who desire, and many times make great sacri-
13 fices to obtain a college education, should not have class and
14 campus disrupted by dissident misfits, anarchists, and non-conform-
15 ists, and

16 WHEREAS, the people of the State of California have a contract
17 with each and every educator in our colleges, to perform specified
18 duties, and

19 WHEREAS, some of these professional educators are not ful-
20 filling their contracts and in fact choosing, by refusing to teach,
21 to void their contracts, and

22 WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa,
23 State of California, does abhor and is dismayed by the illegal,
24 immoral, amoral and unconstitutional acts performed by some students
25 and others at San Francisco State College, and

26 WHEREAS, this same Board of Supervisors suggests that when a
27 contract is broken by an educator, he should be released from duty
28 immediately and his salary terminated, and

29 WHEREAS, this legally constituted governing body has great
30 sympathy and regard for the majority of the students of San Fran-
31 cisco State College, who are striving for a college education, and
32 does feel the pursuit of such should not be interrupted by the

1 closing of the college because of actions of others, and

2 WHEREAS, we hold in highest esteem those educators who have
3 dedicated their lives to the dissemination of knowledge to the
4 aspiring student.

5 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors,
6 of the County of Mariposa, State of California, does commend,
7 endorse and encourage the actions of Acting President of San
8 Francisco State College, S. I. Hayakawa, and the Board of Trustees,
9 California State Colleges, to bring sanity to the campus and re-
10 affirm the right to educate in the classroom and laboratory, and

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Acting President S. I. Hayakawa
12 and the Board of Trustees take whatever legal action necessary to
13 have future peace and order on the campus and in the classrooms of
14 San Francisco State College.


