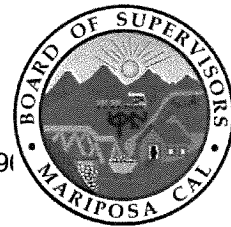

## RESOLUTION - ACTION REQUESTED 2019-350

TO: The Board of Supervisors

RE: Agreement with University of California Irvine to Provide Intensive Youth Treatment Services

---

### RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Approve an Agreement with University of California Irvine (UCI) to provide intensive youth treatment services in an amount not to exceed \$360,000; and authorize the Board of Supervisors Chair to sign the Agreement.

UCI provides a comprehensive scope of services for youth with severe behavioral issues and a multi-disciplinary approach to quality care. UCI provides Medical and Psychiatric Care; Psychological Testing; and Nursing Care. Facilities that provide comprehensive care for youth with such serious needs are in very short supply. Staff conducted an extensive search for an appropriate placement with an opening and could not locate another suitable facility in California.

### BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

The Board of Supervisors does not have prior agreement with University of California Irvine for this specific service.

### ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

Health and Human Services utilizes this facility to serve youth with severe treatment needs. If this agreement is not approved, Health and Human Services will be unable to pay for a client stay and will have no other option but to find alternatives for current and future clients who need this level of care.

### FINANCIAL IMPACT:

**Funding for this contract is incorporated in the FY18/19 budget for the Behavioral Health budget unit 001-0402. There is no impact to the General Fund.**
