RE: Adopt a Resolution Resolution Establishing a Schedule for Parking Penalties

RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Adopt a Resolution Establishing a Schedule of Parking Penalties.

This resolution is a companion to the amendment to Ordinance 10.08.140. That ordinance amendment states that any person violating the parking provisions of that chapter will be subject to a civil parking penalty in amounts set forth by resolution adopted by the Board of Supervisors. This resolution sets forth the parking penalties amounts by category, according to the type of parking violation.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

This resolution was presented to the Board as an informational item at the time the Board waived the first reading and introduced the amendment to Ordinance 10.08.140, on April 6, 2021. The Board directed that the penalty for violations of Mariposa County Code, Chapter 10.08, be set at the maximum allowed, \$100. That change has been incorporated into the resolution. In all other material respects this resolution is the same as presented to the Board on April 6, 2021.

ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

If the resolution is not adopted, newly enacted Mariposa County Code 10.08.140 will not have any penalty amounts and civil enforcement of parking penalties will not be possible.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

It is anticipated that there will be some small increase in revenue depending on the number of parking citations issued. However, any increase may be substantially offset by the cost of administration of citation processing, including administrative appeals.

**MARIPOSA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS RESOLUTION NO. 2021-219
RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING SCHEDULE OF PARKING PENALTIES**

WHEREAS, Mariposa County Ordinance Code, Chapter 10.08 establishes certain areas where parking is prohibited or restricted; and

WHEREAS, the California Vehicle Code establishes certain parking restrictions; and

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code section 40203.5 authorizes the governing body of the local jurisdiction to establish a schedule of parking penalties and encourages the issuing agencies within the same county to standardize parking penalties.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors for the County of Mariposa does hereby establish a schedule of parking penalties for parking violations and late payment penalties.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, pursuant to California Vehicle Code section 40203.5, any person violating any regulation restricting parking, stopping, or standing of vehicles established by statute, ordinance or resolution shall pay the penalty established by the following schedule.

CVC	22507.8	Parked in handicap stall	\$305.00
CVC	22500(b)	Parked in Crosswalk	\$72.00
CVC	22500(f)	Parked on sidewalk	\$72.00
CVC	22500(h)	Double Parked	\$72.00
CVC	22500(l)	Parked blocking handicapped ramp	\$305.00
CVC	22500.1	Parked in fire lane	\$108.00
CVC	22502a	Parked wrong way, more than 18 inches from curb	\$72.00
CVC	22507.8(b)	Parked blocking a handicapped stall	\$305.00
CVC	22507.8c(2)	Parked in Cross hatched area adjacent to handicapped stall	\$305.00

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any person who fails to pay the parking penalty due within 21 days of the date of the citation shall be assessed a late penalty of \$62.00.


