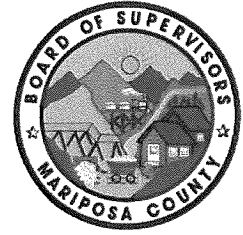

RESOLUTION - ACTION REQUESTED 2021-305

TO: The Board of Supervisors

RE: Declare MCHS Graduation Car Procession through Town of Mpsa on June 1, 2021 a County Sponsored Event

RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Declare the Mariposa County High School Class of 2021 Graduation Car Procession through the Town of Mariposa on June 1, 2021 as a County sponsored event; Authorize the Director of Public Works and Transportation to submit the Caltrans Standard Encroachment Permit Application; and waive any County encroachment permit fees.

The Mariposa County High School Class of 2021 plans to have a car procession through the Town of Mariposa to celebrate their graduation on June 1, 2021 between 5:15 p.m. and 6:00 pm. This event will take place on County roadways and State Routes 140 and 49. (See attached Caltrans Standard Encroachment Permit Application for a description of the route.)

The Mariposa CHP Unit, Mariposa County Sheriff's Office, and Mariposa County Public Works Department will be assisting with safety measures and are supportive of this event.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

The Board has traditionally approved the waiver of encroachment permits for events that benefit the community such as this.

ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

The event may take place without County permission but there could be serious risk and safety considerations.
