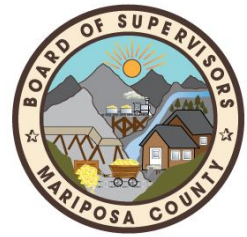

RESOLUTION - ACTION REQUESTED 2021-361

RE: Amendments for the 2020/2021 and 2021/2022 Exotic Pest Detection Trapping Agreement No. 20-0157

RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Approve two supplemental certifications for the Exotic Pest Detection Trapping Agreement No. 20-0157 (RES 2021-254), for FY 2020/2021 and 2021/2022 with the California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA); and Authorize the Board of Supervisors Chair to Sign the Postconsumer-Content Certification (CalRecycle74) and Contractor Certification Clauses (CCC)(4/2017).

The exotic pest detection trapping contract is an annual contract that provides State subvention funds for the pest detection trapping program to cover part of the cost of the program. This contract was first instituted after the 1981 Medfly infestation to cover the costs of the increase in trap numbers over the original County trapping commitment.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

The 2020/2021 and 2021/2022 Exotic Pest Detection Trapping Agreement No. 20-0157 was approved on May 11, 2021, Resolution 2021-254.

ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

Do not approve. Subvention funds will not be received for the Exotic Pest Detection Trapping program to defray the funds expended for work performed in this program for fiscal years 2020/2021 and 2021/2022.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The subvention amount for the Exotic Pest Detection Trapping Program Agreement was included in the FY 2020/2021 budget revenues in the amount of \$31,288 and FY 2021/2022 budget revenues will be in the amount of \$ 31,947.
