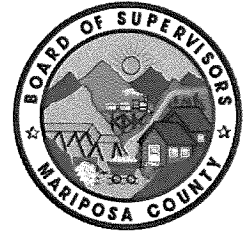

RESOLUTION - ACTION REQUESTED 2021-424

MEETING: July 20, 2021
TO: The Board of Supervisors

RE: Reschedule Regular Meeting to September 15, 2021

RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Reschedule the Board of Supervisors Regular Meeting of September 7, 2021, to Wednesday, September 15, 2021, at 9:00 AM.

On July 5, 2021, the County Clerk advised that the Governor of California had called a special statewide election for September 14, 2021. The effect of this special election is that, under Mariposa County Code Chapter 2.04.010 which speaks to countywide elections, the Board's September 14th meeting is automatically rescheduled to the next Tuesday.

This change to the September 14th meeting results in a three-week span with no Board meeting because August 31st is a Fifth Tuesday (no Board meeting,) and because the Board cancelled the September 7, 2021, meeting when it considered its annual schedule at the first meeting of the year.

The Board discussed the issue on July 13, 2021, and gave direction to reschedule the Regular Meeting of September 7, 2021, to Wednesday, September 15, 2021, at 9:00 AM, in the Government Center. This action fulfills that direction.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

July 13, 2021: The Board discussed the change to the September 14, 2021, Regular meeting which was triggered under Mariposa County Code Chapter 2.04.010 when the Governor called a special statewide election. At that time, the Board gave direction to reschedule the September 7, 2021, meeting to September 15, 2021.

Historically, the Board has adjusted its schedule from time to time (either cancelling or scheduling meetings), as needed.

ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

The Board can choose to not approve to reschedule the meeting, in which case the meeting will not occur and the three week span with no Board meetings will remain.
