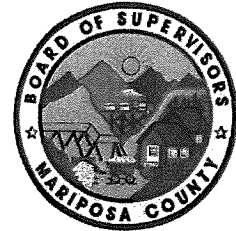

TO: The Board of Supervisors

RE: First Amendment - Today is a New Day Recovery Home Agreement 2021

RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Approve First Amendment with Today is a New Day Recovery Home for residential recovery services to increase the amount by \$1,000 for a new amount not to exceed \$130,600; and authorize the Board of Supervisors Chair to sign the Amendment.

Mariposa County does not operate residential recovery facilities and therefore contracts for such services. There is a need for residential sober living support for those individuals who desire help but cannot stay clean and sober through other means of support, such as utilization of groups offered in the recovery community, traditional counseling services, and Heritage House. Service requirements were greater than anticipated, resulting in this request for additional funding to the agreement.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

The most recent agreement for Today is a New Day Recovery Home was approved by the Board of Supervisors on February 25, 2020 by Resolution 2020-89.

ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

If this amendment is not approved, The County would be delinquent in meeting its financial obligations and increase the risk of HHSA not being able to provide this service to its clients.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

This contract will be paid with Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment funds (SAPT) within the FY20/21 Alcohol & Drug budget unit 001-0403 and fund transfers from Probation for Probation Clients. There is no impact to the County General Fund.

FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR RESIDENTIAL RECOVERY SERVICES

FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR RESIDENTIAL RECOVERY SERVICES, is made and entered into this 15th day of Sept 2021, by and between the County of Mariposa, a political subdivision of the State of California, hereinafter referred to as "County," and Today Is A New Day Recovery Home, hereinafter referred to as "Contractor."

WHEREAS, County and Contractor have heretofore entered into an Agreement dated February 25, 2020, wherein **Contractor** agreed to provide residential recovery services; and

WHEREAS, County and Contractor desire to amend said Agreement to change the compensation to be provided to **Contractor**;


NOW THEREFORE, the parties hereto in consideration of the mutual covenants herein recited, hereby agree as follows:


- 1. Paragraph 2, "COMPENSATION," is hereby amended to provide that an additional \$1,000 will be added to the original amount of \$129,600, making the total compensation paid to Contractor the not to exceed amount of \$130,600.


Except as herein amended, the Agreement dated February 25, 2020 shall remain in full force and effect.


The Agreement, as hereby amended, is ratified and continued. All provisions, terms, covenants, conditions and promises contained in this Agreement not amended herein shall remain in full force and effect. This Amendment is effective retroactive to June 30, 2021. The parties shall treat the Agreement as if it had been in full force and effect continuously since June 30, 2021, without there having been any interruption of the Agreement whatsoever.
