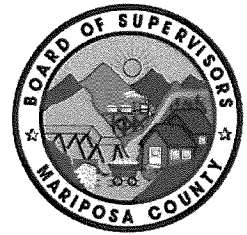

RESOLUTION - ACTION REQUESTED 2021-519

TO: The Board of Supervisors

RE: Approve RFP for Leonard Rd for Survey and Right of Way Acquisition Services

RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Approve a Request for Proposals (RFP) for Leonard Road for Survey and Right of Way Acquisition Services; Authorize the Public Works and Transportation Interim Director to Select the Lowest Responsible Bidder; and Authorize the Board of Supervisors Chair to Sign the Agreement (Subject to Approval as to Legal Form by County Counsel).

The County does not formally control portions of Leonard Road. Roadway easements must be acquired from six property owners in order to receive federal aid to pave between the Stoneridge Mobile Home Park and Harvest Drive. A consultant is required to certify that all Uniform Act requirements are satisfied. RFP tasks include preparation of boundary surveys, plats and legals, escrow, appraisal, and acquisition services.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

On January 12, 2021 Resolution 2021-27 the Board selected Leonard Road for surfacing with CMAQ dollars.

On May 25th, 2021 the Board approved the Program Supplement Agreement with Caltrans for \$150,000 in Preliminary Engineering.

There are no fiscal impacts. The project is 100% funded through the Congestion Management and Air Quality (CMAQ) program.

ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:
