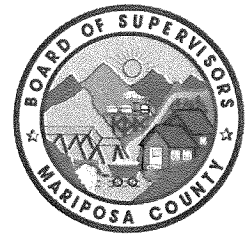

RE: Resolution for Authorization to Apply for FY 2021 Emergency Management Performance Grant Program ARPA

RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Adopt a Resolution of Authorization to Apply for Fiscal Year 2021 Emergency Management Performance Grant Program - American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA); Accept the Allocation of \$60,136.00; and Authorize the Sheriff to Sign the EMPG-ARPA Grant Application; Approve Grant Agreement; and Authorize the Board of Supervisors Chair to Sign the Grant Agreement and any Documents Pertaining to the Grant (Subject to Approval as to Legal Form by County Counsel).

The Board's approval of this Resolution will allow authorized personnel to submit an application for grant funds from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security made available through the California Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES).

Fiscal Year 2021 EMPG-ARPA Local Allocation Schedule awards Mariposa County \$60,136.00 which has been included in the FY 2021-22 requested budget.

This annual grant requires a 1:1 match. Department general fund salaries, office rent and overhead account for the County's match. The intent of the grant is to support local efforts to protect against, mitigate the effects of, respond to, and recover from natural or human-caused disasters and other catastrophic events. The funds provided by this grant help to prepare the nation for the threats and hazards that pose the greatest risk to lives, property, and the environment in the United States. EMPG-ARPA provides funding to implement projects that enhance all-hazards preparedness and serve to build, sustain, and deliver 32 core capabilities across the five Mission Areas of the National Preparedness Goal (NPG). These Mission Areas, which are essential to the security and resilience of the nation, are Prevention, Protection, Mitigation, Response, and Recovery. The building, sustainment, and delivery of these core capabilities require the combined effort of the whole community, including public, private, and tribal entities. The expenditure requirements are the same as the EMPG grant and the EMPG-ARPA grant is separate additional funds to support the EMPG mission.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

The Mariposa County Board of Supervisors has approved and supported similar

program applications and grants in past years, such as the EMPG-Supplemental in FY 2020-21.

ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

Not participate and lose the opportunity for these grant funds that support personnel, project and training costs associated with the county's Office of Emergency Services.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The EMPG program requires a 1:1 match. The county's portion is met through apportionment of general fund staff wages and an apportioned percentage of office rent, technology, provided trainings and office expenses. Revenue and Appropriations of \$60,136 have been included in the FY 2021/22 requested budget in Fund 452.

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION TO THE CALIFORNIA OFFICE OF
EMERGENCY SERVICES FOR FUNDS UNDER THE FISCAL YEAR 2021
EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PERFORMANCE GRANT PROGRAM -
AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT**

WHEREAS, the California Office of Emergency Services administers the Emergency Management Performance Grant Program - ARPA; and

WHEREAS, the County of Mariposa is an eligible entity to submit an application to the California Office of Emergency Services for grant funding in the FY21 grant cycle to provide funding for emergency management activities that will enhance local government's capability to prevent, prepare for, mitigate against, respond to, and recover from disasters whether natural or man-made; and

WHEREAS, the funding is provided through the United States Department of Homeland Security, and sub-granted through the California Office of Emergency Services; and

WHEREAS, receiving of and filing the grant application is of utmost importance as deadlines are attached.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa, State of California, as follows:

1. This Board approves the filing of an application and receipt of funding for the FY 2021 Emergency Management Performance Grant Program - ARPA.

2. This Board authorizes the following personnel to execute for and on behalf of the County of Mariposa, a public entity established under laws of the State of California, any actions necessary for the purpose of obtaining federal financial assistance provided by the Federal Department of Homeland Security and sub-granted through the State of California in the FY 2021 Emergency Management Performance Grant Program - ARPA:

- (a) County Administrative Officer
- (b) Sheriff
- (c) Public Works Director
- (d) Public Health Officer
- (e) County Counsel

3. The County Administrative Officer, or his designee, is hereby designated as the authorized representative for public assistance, and the County Administrative Officer, or his designee, is hereby designated as the authorized representative for individual assistance of the County of Mariposa for purpose of receipt, processing and coordination of all inquiries and requirements necessary to obtain available state and federal assistance.
