10.12.030 Forest Road.

It is unlawful for the owner, possessor, or driver of any motor vehicle weighing in excess of fifteen tons, gross laden weight, to permit or cause the same to travel that portion of the Forest Road situate within the boundaries of Fish Camp subdivision between the junction of the Forest Road and State Highway 41 to a point 0.36 miles westerly. (Ord. 305 Sec.1, 1968).

10.12.040 Scott Road.

It is unlawful for the owner, possessor, or driver of any motor vehicle weighing in excess of fifteen tons, gross laden weight, to permit or cause the same to travel the Scott Road particularly described as follows: an existing road within the westerly half of Section 22, beginning at a point near the southerly line of said Section 22 at the intersection of said road and the Best Road (a county road), then running northwesterly, northerly, and northeasterly, approximately one mile, to the point of intersection of the Scott Road and the Best Road, near the northerly line of said Section 22, T4S, R19E, M.D.B. & M. (Ord. 305 Sec.2, 1968).

10.12.050 (Repealed).10.12.060 Exception for commercial vehicles.

This chapter shall not prohibit any commercial vehicle from using any enumerated county highway by direct route to, or from, a state highway for the purpose of delivering or loading for transportation goods, wares, and merchandise. (Ord. 469 Sec.B (49--52), 1977; Ord. 306 Sec.3, 1969; Ord. 305 Sec.4, 1968; Ord. 296 Sec.3, 1967; Ord. 288 Sec.4, 1967).

PILOT CAR REQUIREMENTS

Truck and trailers hauling legal widths UP TO 12'

Merced Falls Road and Hornitos Road ONLY – NO PILOT CAR REQUIRED

TWO (2) PILOT CARS REQUIRED ON ALL OTHER COUNTY ROADS

Truck and trailers hauling OVER 12' widths

TWO (2) PILOT CARS REQUIRED on all County roads except on Merced Falls Road and Hornitos Road (one (1) pilot car may be used on Merced Falls Road and Hornitos Road)

All Mobile Homes and Modulars

TWO (2) PILOT CARS REQUIRED ON ALL COUNTY ROADS

House Boats

TWO (2) PILOT CARS REQUIRED AT ALL TIMES, ON ALL COUNTY ROADS

The Mariposa County Public Works Department, at its discretion, reserved the right to make exception to any of the above requirements.

All exceptions shall be noted on the permit.
